HEXAGONAL TABLE LAMPS





Created in the late 60s, this lamp was inspired by a stone model of the Dunbar collection designed by Edward J. Wormley in 1959. Jules Wabbes reinterpreted this classic model. The first copies made of travertine were produced by Mobilier Universel. They were later made of metal and distributed by General Decoration in 1969. The cotton lampshade is simply held by three notched metal rods.






Small Hexagonal Table Lamp, 1969










Large Hexagonal Table Lamp, 1969





At the time Jules Wabbes was an antique dealer, he transformed antique Chinese celadon vases into lamps. The early model of the Hexagonal Table Lamp was produced in ceramic, this is how he developed the fixation system of the lamp bulb and the shade. He asked his friend pottery artist Antoine de Vincke for a lamp stand in terra cotta.

Jules Wabbes also designed the same lamp in travertine stone, and finally in 1969, he developed the raw and polished bronze models.

For Wabbes, above all, it is the material that counts. In the early '70s Wabbes already acquired the marble from De Merbes Sprimont. «"This is the reason why we wanted to use stone again and most of all tell a Belgian story" say Vincent and Caroline. "When Isabelle Croonenberghs (Cromarbo) showed us the Belgian Gris des Ardennes marble we had our story!"

Production is limited to 50 pieces.
