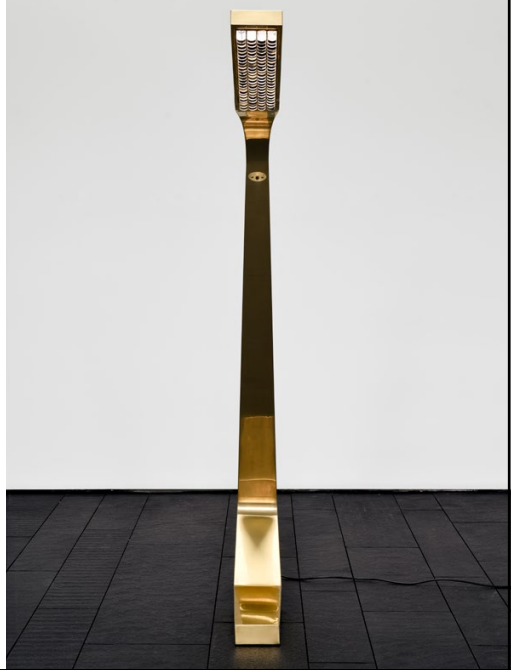


M57 BRASS, 1957



The M57 lamp, simply referred to in the past by Jules Wabbes as the “Double-position lighting device”, which had been exhibited at the XI Triennale in Milan in 1957, had disappeared. Despite its spectacular dimensions, the beauty of its design, the light filtered by fins that varied depending on the position of the foot, this exceptional model had never been commercialised.

In the year 2024, thanks to technological advancements, the M57 will finally be produced in limited edition on the occasion of the 50th anniversary of Jules Wabbes’ disappearance.

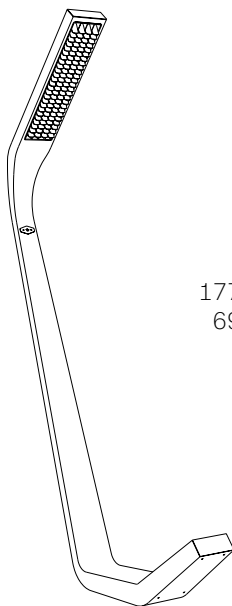

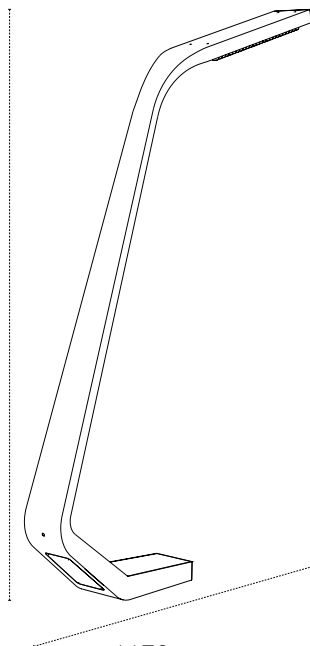
